Dr. M. Easwaramoorthi, coordinator of the strategic plan review committee, outlined the key features of the 2021-26 Strategic Plan. He also put forth the deliberations had with the reconstituted strategic planning committee members and different stakeholders to identify potential key areas and parameters to be included for formulating the revised strategic plan. The summary of the key points considered for formulating the strategic plan 2021-26 is provided below.

Implementation of New Education Policy 2020

- Multi-disciplinary, holistic Under Graduate education with flexible curricula, creative combinations of subjects, integration of vocational education.

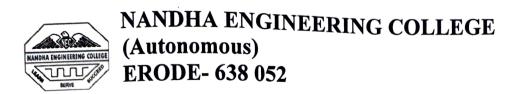

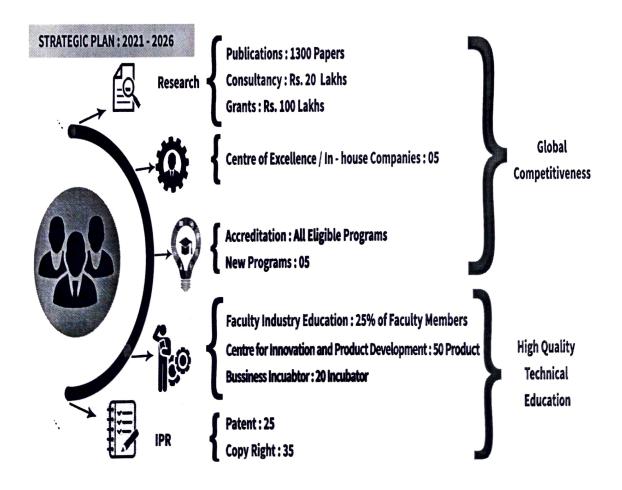
