

Students may be permitted to register for online courses (which are provided with certificate) as specified in clause 5.10. On successful completion of the online courses, DCAA will assess the online courses by providing 75% weightage to the marks earned through online courses and 25% weightage to the assessment by DCAA by retaining the credits specified in the certification. Online course of 3 credits can be considered instead of one elective course (PSE/OE). The grading shall be awarded as per clause 16.1 with the prior approval of Principal.	marks will be calculated by multiplying the marks earned through online course with a factor of 1.25 as per recommendations of DAB

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
