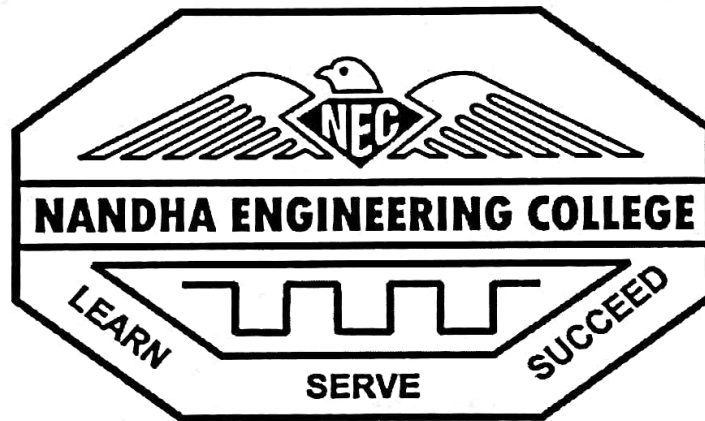

Online course of 3 credits can be considered instead of one elective course (PSE/OE).
