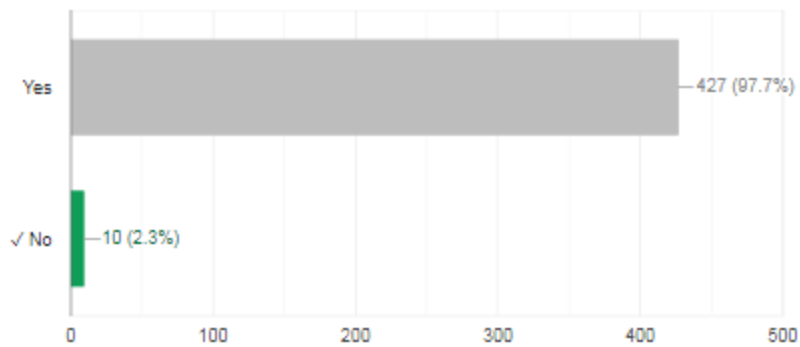

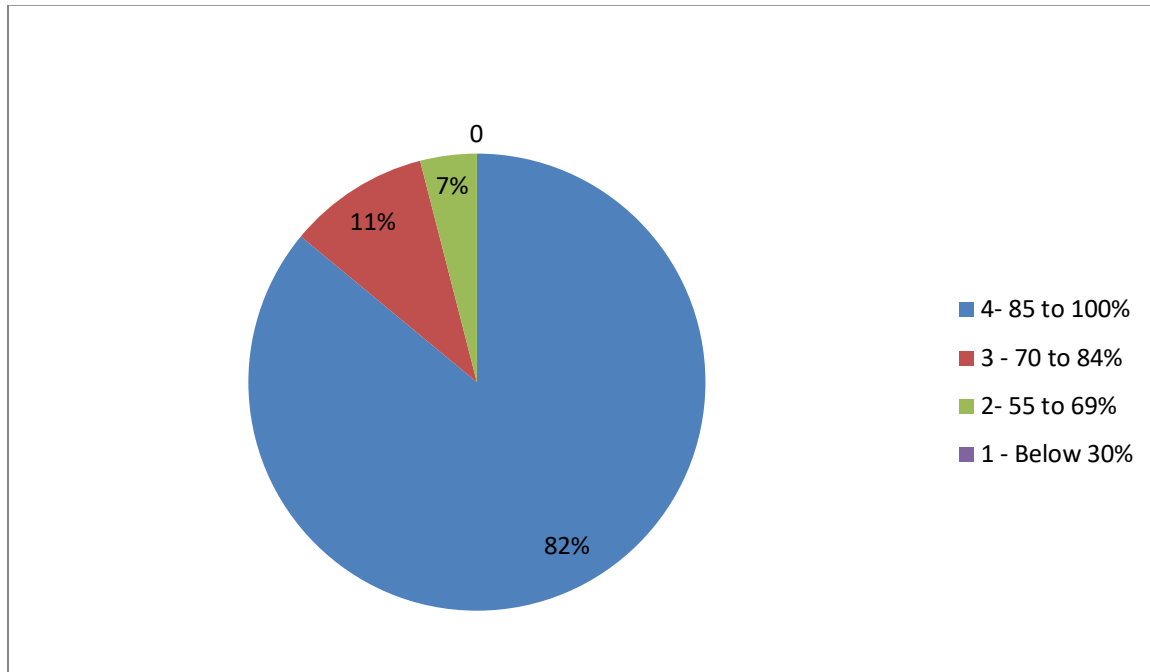

1. How much of syllabus was covered in the class?



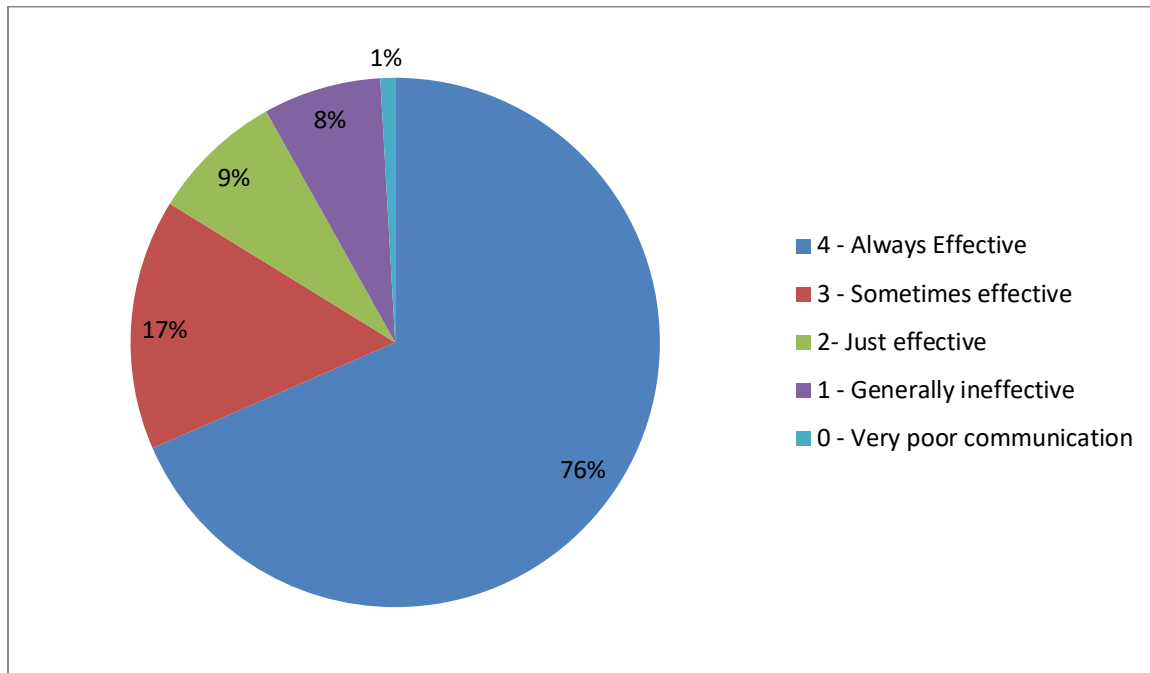
- 82% of faculty members completes 85 to 100% syllabus

- Remaining faculty members are advised to improve their class preparation and plan for effective content delivery.

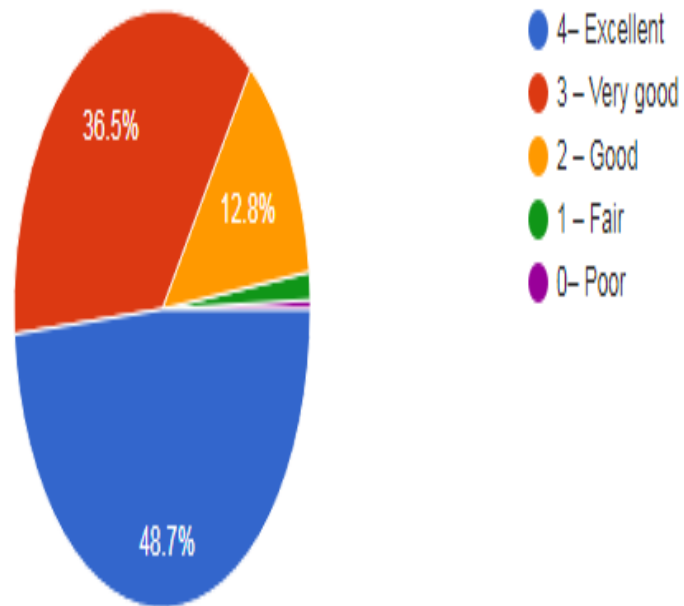
### 3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

#### 4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

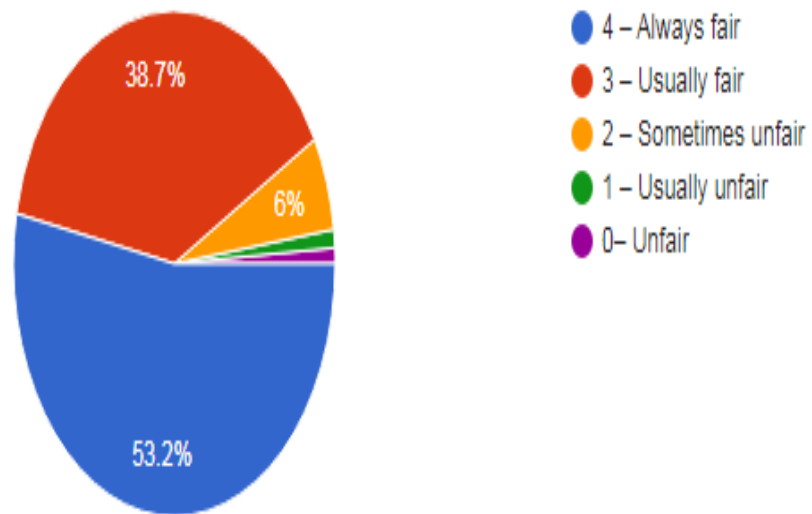

## 5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.

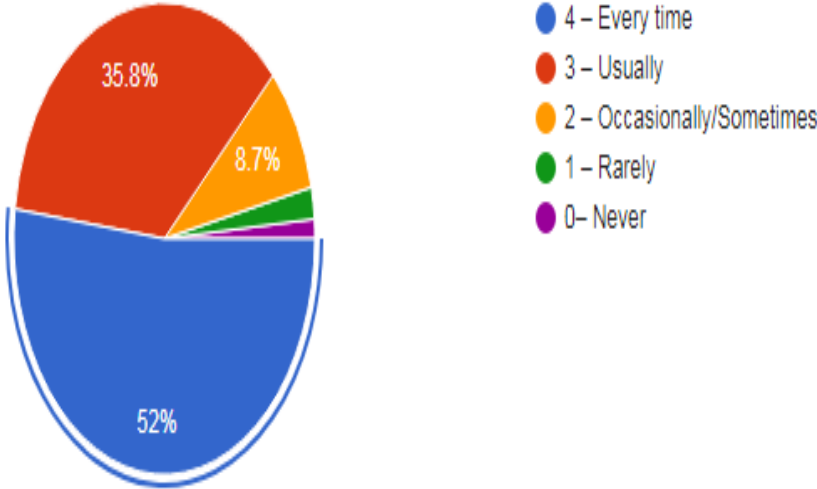
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- 91.3% of teachers are usually fair in their evaluation.

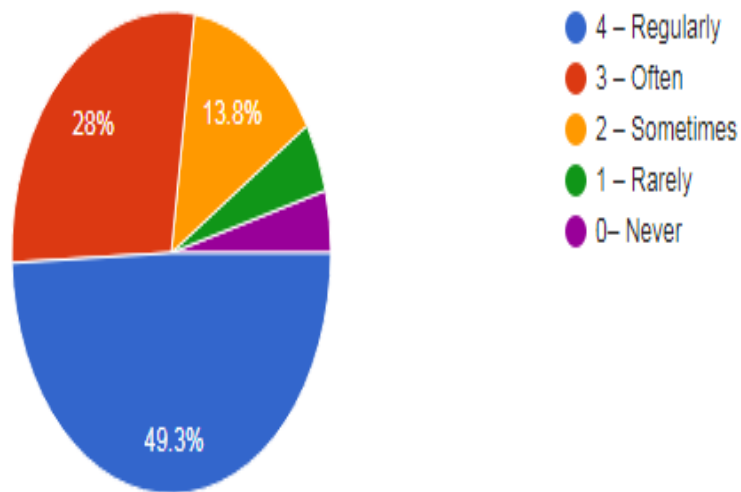


- 96.5% of teachers has discussed the assignments with students.

7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.

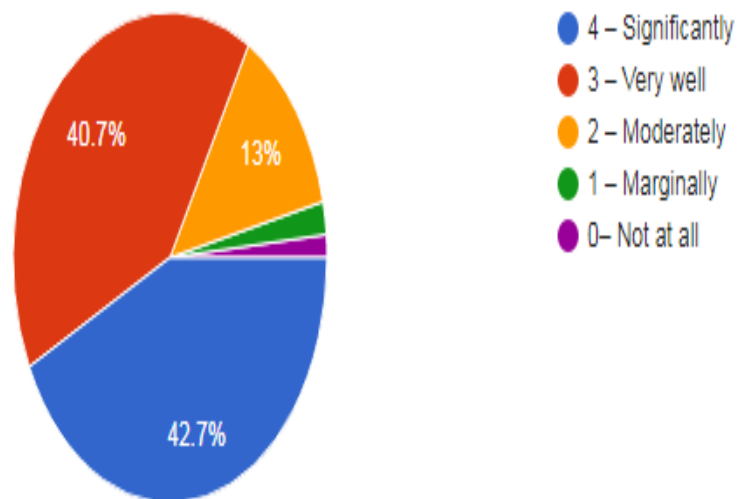
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➤ Students are encouraged to attend Inpaint training, Industrial visit, field trip, Internship and the department actively follows the progress.

8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.

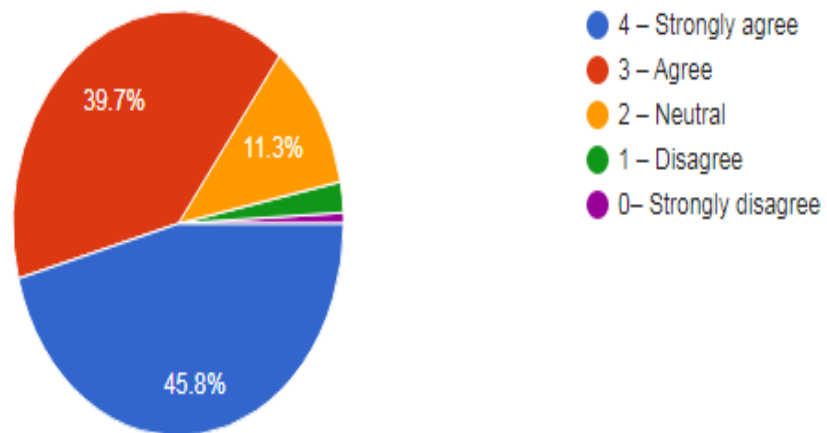
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➤ The institute has well teaching and mentoring process.

9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

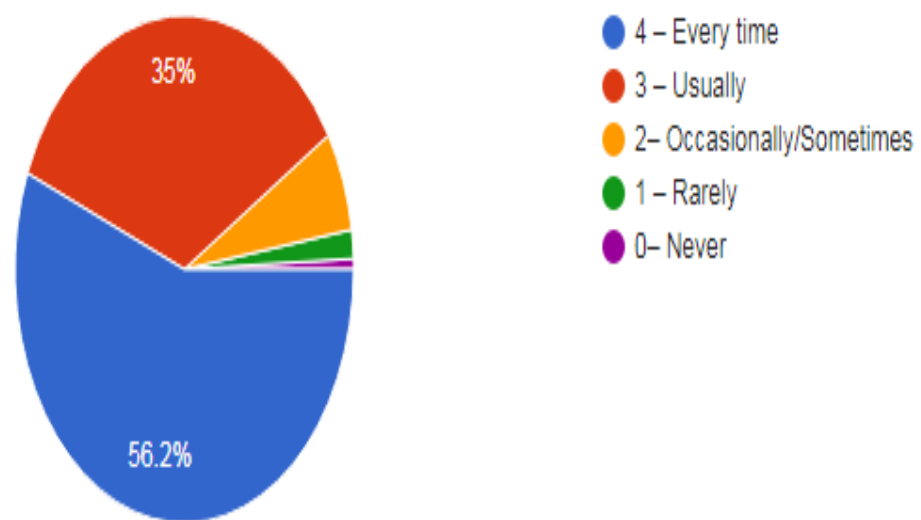
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➤ Most of the students agree with the provision of multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

## 10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.

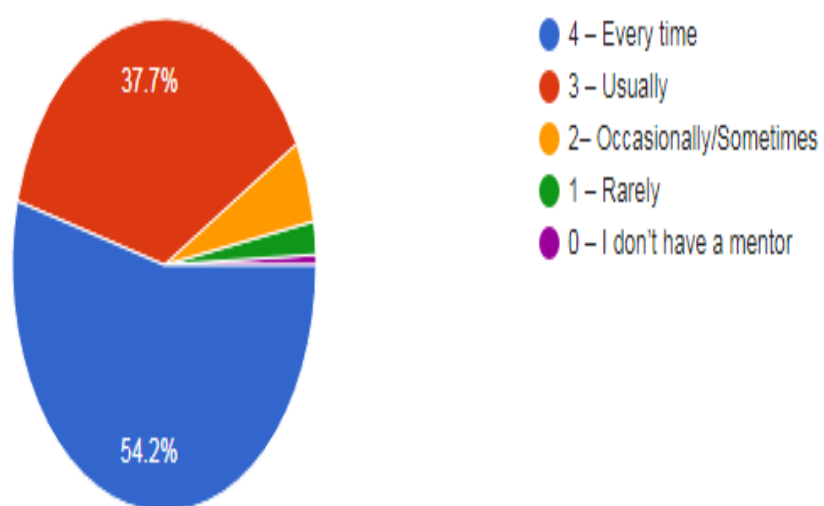
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- 91.2% of teachers are informing about competencies, course outcomes and program outcomes.

11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.

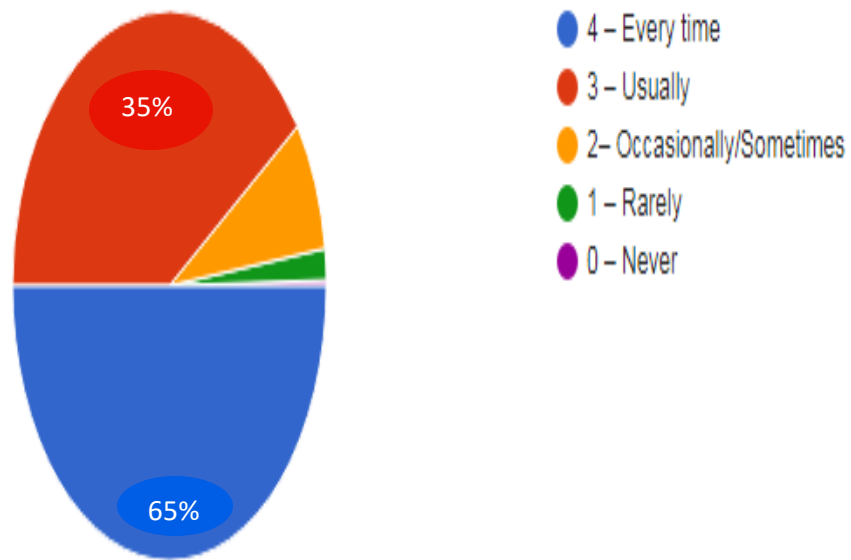
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➤ 96.3% of students agree with the effective implementation mentoring process and the follow up actions.

## 12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.

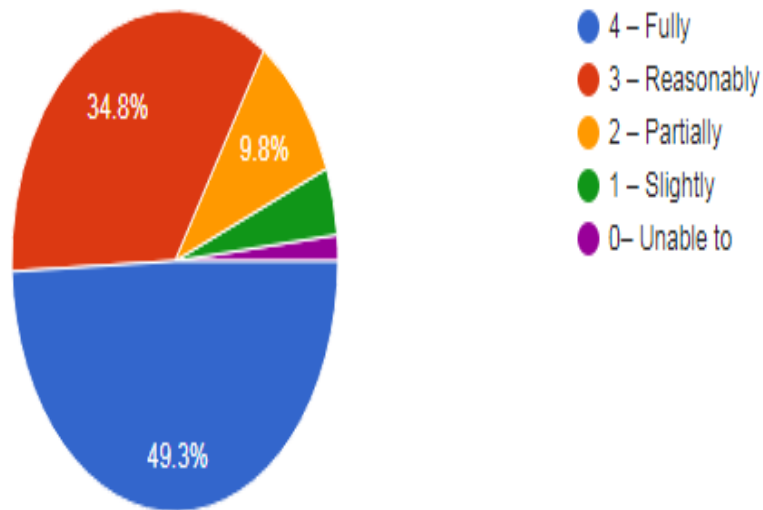
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- 65% of the teachers explain the concepts through examples and real time applications.

13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.

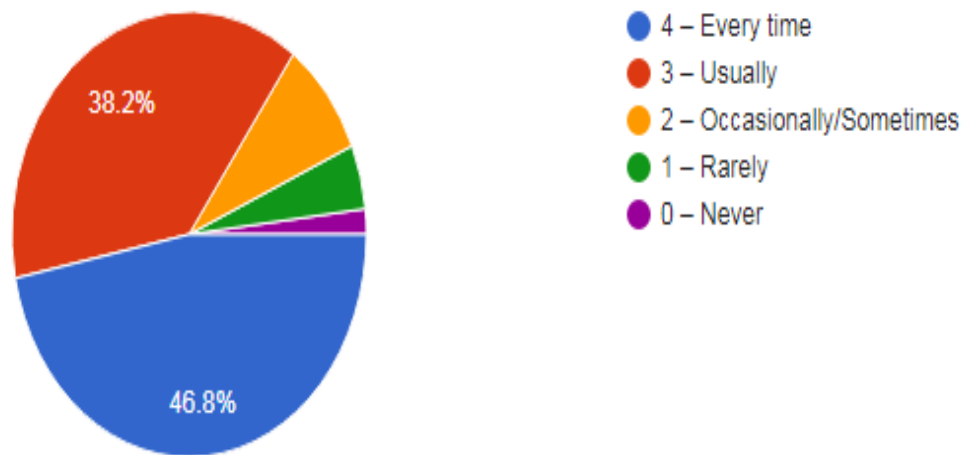

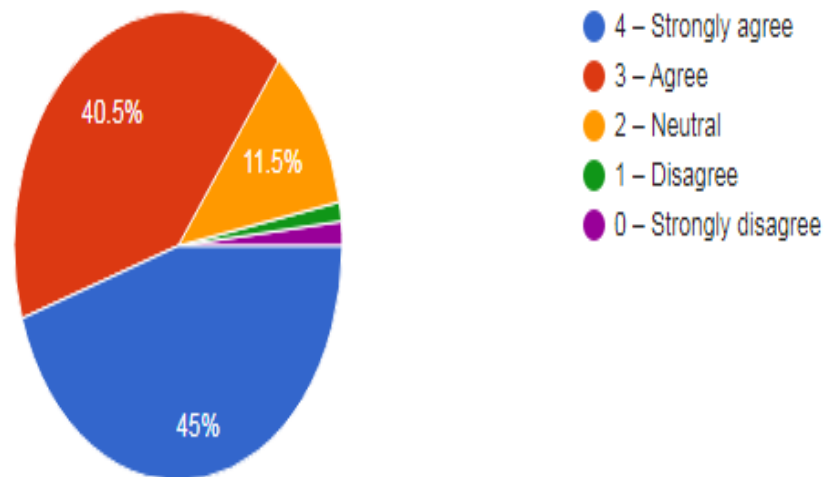


- Teachers motivates the students to overcome their weakness by arranging special classes and counseling.

15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.

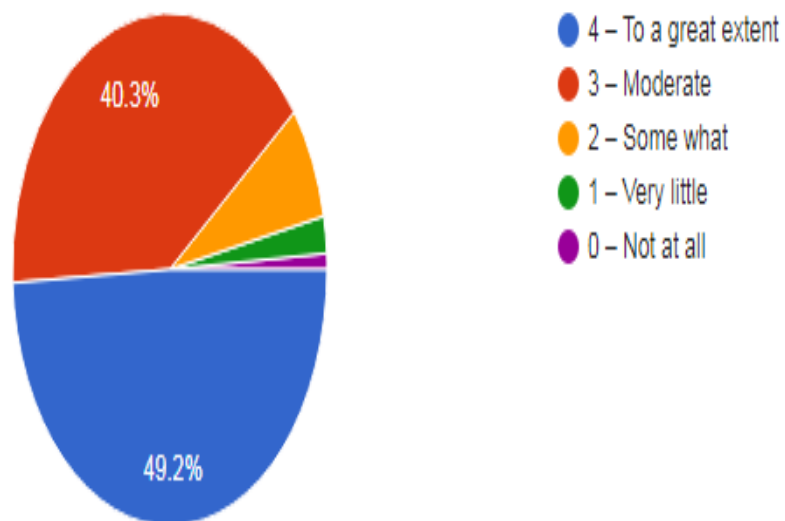
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➤ 97% of students agrees with monitoring and continuous quality improvement of teaching learning process.

16. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.

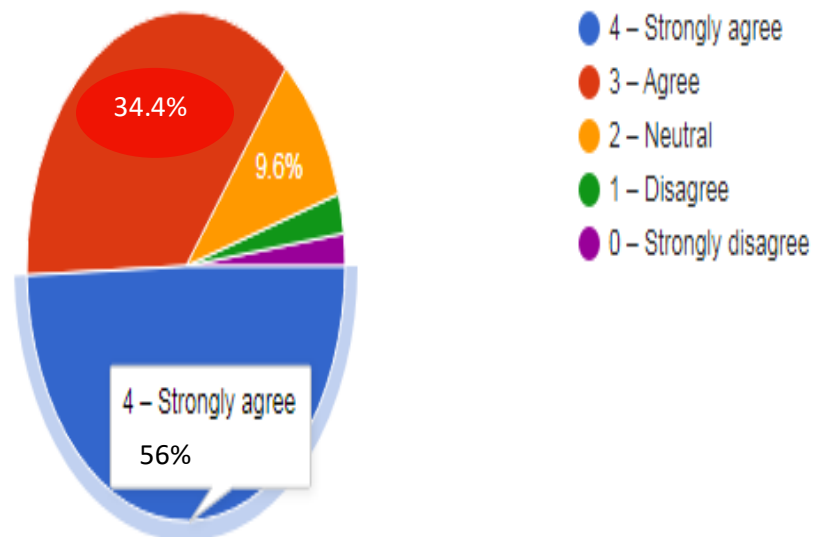

## 17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.

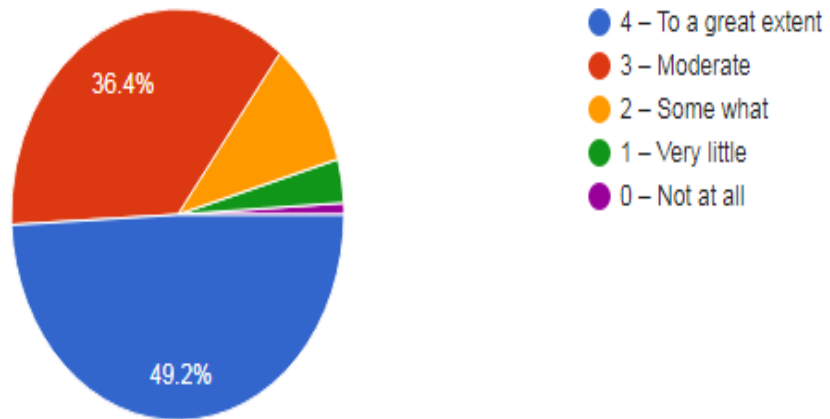

18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.

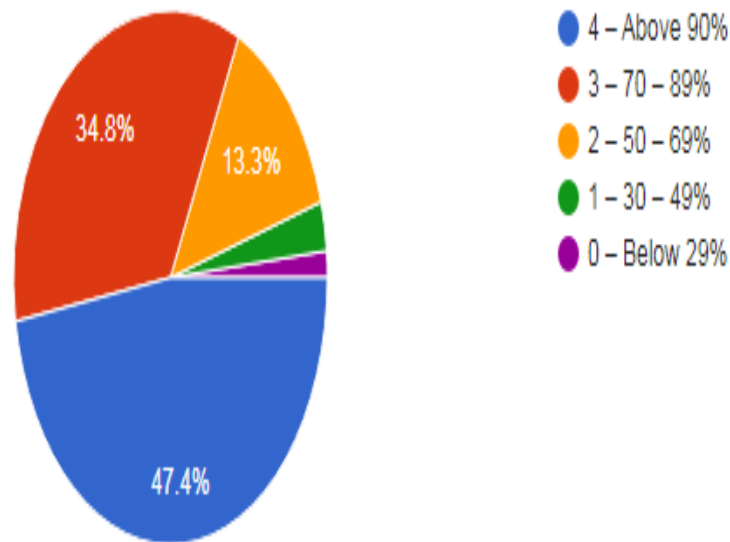

19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.

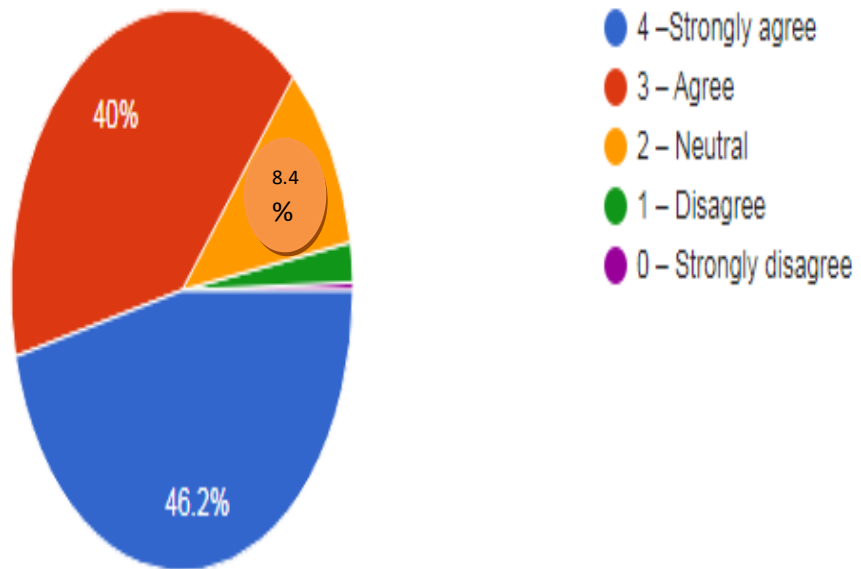
