Discussion	Dr.V.Karunanidhi, AP/English, SRM Institute of Science and Technology suggested the following points: <p><b>2022-2026Batch:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He suggested that instead of having Soft/Analytical Skills V &amp; Soft/Analytical Skills VI in the 5<sup>th</sup> semester and6<sup>th</sup> semester, the Soft / Analytical Skills V and VI shall be merged and offered in the 5<sup>th</sup> semester alone as Communication and Quantitative Reasoning.</li> </ul> <p><b>2023–2027Batch:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He suggested that instead of having Soft/Analytical Skills V&amp; Soft/Analytical Skills VI in the 5<sup>th</sup> semester and 6<sup>th</sup> semester, the Soft /Analytical SkillsV and VI shall be merged and offered in the 5<sup>th</sup> semester alone as Communication and Quantitative Reasoning.</li> <li>• Further, the expert suggested that the syllabi of Soft/Analytical Skills III and IV shall be modified by incorporating LSRW Skills besides Grammar and offered in the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> semesters respectively.</li> </ul> <p><b>2024–2028Batch:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He suggested that instead of having Soft/Analytical Skills I–VI, Soft / Analytical Skills I – IV shall be offered form the 2<sup>nd</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> semesters by incorporating contents of Soft / Analytical Skills I – VI.</li> </ul>

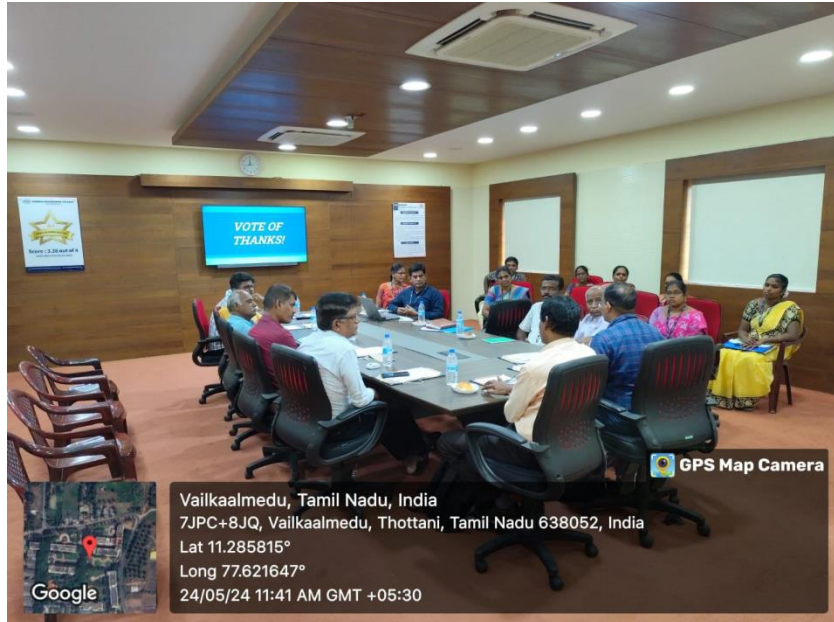
