Common points

1. Assignments were given at the end of the semester, making it difficult for students to complete them on time. The assignment submission deadline has been fixed as July 2, 2025.
2. The Principal emphasized that assignments should be given at least 15 working days in advance to allow adequate preparation time.
3. Classrooms in Block-5 are affected by unpleasant odors from nearby toilets. The Principal has instructed that the toilets be cleaned after every break.
4. A non-teaching staff member should be deputed during the evening hours to clean the first-year classrooms daily.
5. Rainwater leakage has been reported in Buses No. 13, 16, 42, 82, and 76. This issue needs to be addressed immediately.
6. Buses No. 17 and 81 are overcrowded. Additional bus services are required on these routes.
7. The napkin disposal area in the girls' toilet in Block-9 needs to be cleaned regularly.
8. Drinking water facilities are required on the second and third floors of Block-9.
9. Students are requested to use the washbasins in restrooms to wash their hands during lunch. If this is not feasible, additional facilities should be arranged. *in Block 9.*
10. In Bus No. 70, the seats are not properly fixed, making it uncomfortable and unsafe for travel.
11. Buses after remedial classes are operating too late in the evening. Students have requested that bus services be made available by 6:15 PM.
12. In the NRI-2 block, there are issues with drinking water, and the quality of food needs improvement.
13. Students have requested that placement fee details be communicated prior to the exam fee circular. Last-minute notices make it difficult to arrange the required amount in time.
